- Not going to the Net for close plays
- Too Quiet Be Loud, Use your voice to avoid situations at the net
- Late Line Changes Kick Out Centers

The Ugly

- Wonky Signals Be Confident in your call, Straight and Assertive Signals
- No Selling Feature- you cannot call every offiside icing the same way

- Making the Right Call Offsides, Icings)
- Consistent standards

The Bad

- Not Covering Partner Leaving too soon
- Puck Focus (Penalties being missed) Read/Predict the Play, Look Behind
- Not following the players to the bench on line changes
